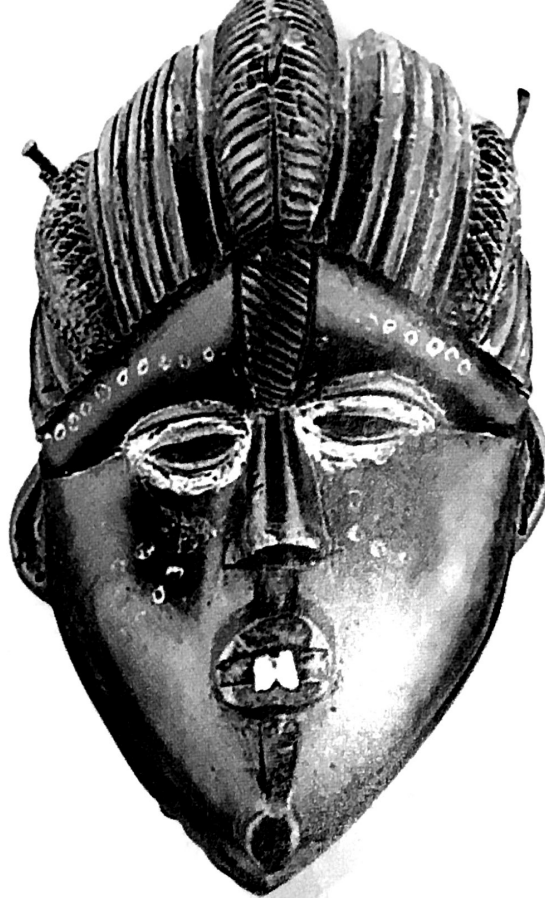


3. In 1987, the museum collection was moved to its present underground facility.

- EXAMPLES **What** is the first event in the contest?
 Who is going to represent our team?
 To **whom** is the e-mail addressed?
 Which of the books are you reading?
 Whose is the car in the driveway?
